97 singles for 9,849 bed nights

39 singles living with HIV/AIDS

78 families (**222** individuals, incl. **136** children/youth) for 36,283 bed nights

154 families (**510** individuals, incl. **278** children/youth) for 8,252 bed nights

1,244 single adults for 26,082 bed nights

61 boys in our youth shelter for 628 bed nights

reStart provided outreach support through our hotline to **151** youth

reStart provided day services at the Homeless Services Center to **2,993** homeless persons

reStart provided permanent housing placements at A New Start for **17** chronically homeless adults

with a severe and persistent mental illness for 3,830 bed nights
